1. Login




Click on Login to access the login area. As a DGNB Consultant or DGNB Auditor, the DGNB will automatically create an account for you. You do not need to register yourself. If the system does not recognise your user, please contact Anna-Lisa Schmid (al.schmid@dgnb.de).

There are two options on how to proceed with your login:

Option 1: You log in to a DGNB application for the first time.


Option 2: You have already logged in to one of our systems.





Option 1: You log in to a DGNB application for the first time with your access data.

Please click on "Forgotten password" during your very first login to assign a password.



After clicking on "Forgotten password" you will be asked to enter your e-mail address (= user name).

You complete your registration and assign a password via a double opt-in procedure.

Option 2: You already have an account in the DGNB System Software

Please log in with your email address as username and your already assigned password. This does NOT yet apply to our website and the associated internal area – this application has not yet been connected to our new user administration.

2. Selection menu




- Products: here you can access the product list. You will see products that have been posted by manufacturers and can also be found on the publicly accessible product database (https://dgnb-navigator.de/produktdatenbank). You will also see so-called "auditor products". Products that have been created by other DGNB auditors and audited by the DGNB.
- **Project list**: here you can access your projects. You can create new projects, edit existing projects and much more..

3. Products

3.1. Product list



You can view the product (IMPORTANT: the view is only available for manufacturer products - see column "Owner Type"), copy it, paste it into a project and mark it as a favourite.

Columns explained:

1. Product name

2. Manufacturer name

3. Product number / registration code: erleichtert die Suche → nur Herstellerprodukte haben einen Registrierungscode

4. QS (Quality level)

QS is the quality level according to which the construction products are assessed in connection with the criterion ENV1.2 (risks for the local environment). If a product has this rating and you have selected the MKM version filter, the corresponding result is shown in the QS column. As there can be several QS for one product, the "MKM version filter" is available here..

5. MKM Status

The MKM status indicates the status of the QS rating. This status is independent of the status of the product. There are the following statuses:

Product list



Assessed = Assessed by a DGNB auditor or manufacturer but not yet audited by the DGNB.

Audited = audited by the DGNB but not yet published

Published = audited and published by the DGNB visible to every user on


6. Updated

This column shows when the product was created and last edited or checked (depending on the status, see 9. Status)

7. Owner type

A product can either belong to a manufacturer or to a DGNB auditor. If the product belongs to a manufacturer, it is also published at: https://www.dgnb-navigator.de/produktdatenbank

Click on the following button in the product list to call up the product page.:

If the product belongs to a DGNB auditor, it is not published. This product is also called auditor product and is only visible to administrators and other DGNB auditors/consultants.

If the auditor product is assigned to a registered manufacturer but was not created by the manufacturer himself, the manufacturer can see it in his product list and claim it for himself if he wishes to. He can then complete the product and publish it after successful auditing by the DGNB. As a result, the owner type changes to "Manufacturer" and the product is publicly visible.

As a DGNB auditor, you cannot edit a manufacturer's product, but you can add a new QA to this product (for example, in another version that does not yet exist). You cannot edit/update an existing MKM assessment. Please contact the DGNB (navigator@dgnb.de) if you want to edit/update a quality level in a manufacturer product.

8. Label

False = the product does not have a DGNB Navigator label

True = the product has a DGNB Navigator label

9. Status

Main status: there are three main statuses

- Published (visible to the public) in our product database: https://www.dgnb-navigator.de/produktdatenbank
- Non-published (not visible to the public, but visible to DGNB auditors)
- Deleted (deleted and only visible to yourself, neither to the public nor to DGNB auditors).

Edit status/ editing status: there are three editing statuses


- In progress (the product is currently being processed by you or your colleagues)
- In review (the product is currently being reviewed by the DGNB)
- None (the product is neither being tested nor processed)

3.2. Add new product

3.2.1. General information



- Registration code: is assigned automatically
- Cost group: Inclusion of the product profile in a cost group, e.g. technical installations.
- Secondary cost group: Inclusion of the product profile in a secondary cost group, e.g.
 Ventilation systems, KG 430
- Materiality: Enter if the product consists of at least 10% of the specified materials
- Product name: Enter the product name (mandatory field). A list of already existing product names will be displayed to avoid duplicates
- Manufacturer: Enter the manufacturer (mandatory field) and a list of existing
 manufacturers will appear to avoid duplicates. If a manufacturer appears in the list,
 please select it. If no suggestion is made, add a new manufacturer.
 User Notes: Enter a short information (free text)

3.2.2. Criteria




You can now enter product characteristics for the products. Please note to provide each field with content. If no information is available, the information must also be deposited. In order to obtain a uniform declaration, "no information" must be used if no data is available.

Criterion ENV1.2 with quality level assessment



Classification of the quality levels:

- 1. Select the version according to which you want to carry out the evaluation.
- 2. Download the Excel file under "Download: Excel for quality level assessment". This Excel supports you in the assessment and serves as proof documentation.
- 3. Upload the completed Excel file as well as other necessary evidence under "Evidence documentation" again.
- 4. the MKM status is filled automatically
- 5. indicate the quality level achieved under "Quality level achieved "

Dropdown selection field: Here you have the option of conveniently selecting and storing the appropriate selection for your product from various predefined entries. If none of the entries apply or no entries are possible, select "No entries".




If there are any questions about individual indicators or if the selection cannot be assigned directly, click on the question mark to find help for each criterion.

Primary information source: The primary information source is stored in the data source. This can be, for example: EMICODE, Blue Angel, EPD No., version Ökobau.dat, manufacturer. If you have selected "no information", you can leave this field open..

Data quality: For each specification and data source, a data source must also be deposited. The different data sources are explained in more detail in a table. Here it is also possible to leave the field open when selecting "no specification".




- Summary: In this control window, all details and documents are clearly displayed
- In case of errors/supplements, please select the corresponding field and edit it afterwards.
- Send for evaluation: The product note opens and you can send your product for assessment. The product is now visible to the DGNB Navigator team.

3.2.4. Product notes



If you click on the "Send for assessment" button, you can add a note to the DGNB or also send test documents that are not to be published. To do this, please click on "Files ".

Click on the "Submit" button to send your product to the DGNB for inspection.




4. Product testing procedure

- After entering the data in the product profile, the product details are transmitted to the DGNB Navigator team.
- The entered data is checked for completeness and plausibility. After the check by the DGNB, you will receive an automated e-mail about the successful check and the publication of your product.
- If any information is missing, the product will be sent back to you for further submission. Once you have adjusted the changes, you can send the product back to the DGNB for a second assessment. The process is the same as for the first assessment and test.


